



SPECTATORS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Children play organised sports for fun. They are not playing for the entertainment of spectators only, nor are they miniature professionals.
2. Applaud good performances and efforts by your team and their opponents. Congratulate both teams upon their performance regardless of the result.
3. Respect official decisions. If there is a disagreement, follow the appropriate procedure in order to question the decision and teach children to do likewise.

5. Never ridicule or scold a child for making a mistake during a match. Positive comments are motivational.
6. Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, officials or Players.
7. Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them there would be no match.
8. Encourage players to play according to the rules and to obey official decisions.
9. Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul or abusive language, or harassing Players, coaches or officials.
