



SPECTATORS CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Children play organised sports for fun. They are not playing for the entertainment of spectators only, nor are they miniature professionals.
- 2. Applaud good performances and efforts by your team and their opponents. Congratulate both teams upon their performance regardless of the result.
- 3. Respect official decisions. If there is a disagreement, follow the appropriate procedure in order to question the decision and teach children to do likewise.

- 5. Never ridicule or scold a child for making a mistake during a match. Positive comments are motivational.
- 6. Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, officials or Players.
- 7. Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them there would be no match.
- 8. Encourage players to play according to the rules and to obey official decisions.
- 9. Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul or abusive language, or harassing Players, coaches or officials.
